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October Mission Trip to Southwestern China

In October, I made a two-week mission trip to **Sichuan** and **Guangxi provinces in China**. Nearly total **900 people** were ministered to at **10 places**. This trip was different from past ones that I started at a major city and then travelled to the nearby smaller cities, so I can stay in the city comfortably with a dedicated car as the transportation, and travel with a lighter luggage. In the meetings, **the sisters were still the majority than the brothers**. The Southwestern region in China still needs more gospel work. This was also **my first time to minister in Guangxi** in nearly 20 years. Not many gospel workers came to minister in this region. **Outreach work is desperately needed** to increase the number of the believers in the local churches, as the majority of the population still engages in idol-worship.

I first arrived at a major city in **Sichuan**. I was arranged to stay at a mansion in the city. Early next morning, we went to a nearby city for the coworker meeting at their new facility. After my preaching, they responded in tears. When I prayed for them, sisters fell down in tears and brothers fell down quietly. After preaching in the afternoon, I prayed for them again in groups. The sisters were filled with great joy. Lastly, I anointed the main coworkers and prophesied over them. They wept strongly and then embraced each other. **Many were touched and in tears**. As we returned to the major city, we were stuck in traffic for hours because of a terrible accident blocking the highway.

The next afternoon we met at a house church in the city with many young people. After preaching, I gave an alter call and many responded in tears. More people came and packed the meeting hall in the evening. After preaching with the anointing, I prayed for them in groups and they fell quietly for a long time. Lastly, I prayed for the young people to be filled with the Holy Spirit. The next morning, we held a combined church meeting in the city and many people came from various house churches. After preaching, I gave an alter call of repentance and many were in tears. People pushed forward to receive prayers. Later I prayed for them in groups and they fell down quietly. Many older people with illnesses later testified about their healings. We were then notified that the public officials already came. We decided to end the meeting early and I had to leave at once. In the afternoon, I met with some coworkers at a local teahouse to answer their questions. Later I prayed for them and many fell in tears. I took a high-speed train that evening to the next city.

The next morning, we held a meeting at a facility in the mountain. Coworkers came from the nearby city with sisters as the majority. After preaching, I prayed for them in groups and they all fell down in tears. In the afternoon, after preaching I prayed for them again and they were filled with great joy. In the evening, I went to a house meeting of another church. Although not many people showed up, their worship was passionate. After preaching, I prayed for each of them. Some wept, some received healings, and some spoke in tongue. Their coworkers were filled with great joy. I took the high-speed train back to the major city

the next day and then took an overnight train to the next city.

After I arrived the next morning, we went to a nearby village for the coworker meeting. After preaching, I first prayed for **young people in the Bible school** and they all fell in weeping strongly. After preaching in the afternoon, I prayed again for young people and they were filled with joy in great laughter. I then took the overnight train back to the major city. After some rest, I took an evening flight to a major city in **Guangxi** next evening. Coworkers picked me up and then travelled to another city at midnight.

In the next morning, we held a house meeting with people came from surrounding areas. After preaching, I prayed for them. Some fell already without being touched and many fell in tears. It was the first-time experience for them. I prayed for them again in the afternoon. They fell down and spoke in tongues, then filled with joy. Lastly, I prayed for the sick and anointed the towels. Later some gave the testimonies of their healings. We then took the train back to the major city. The next morning, we met in an office building with mainly the young people. After preaching, I prayed for them and many fell down in tears. In the afternoon, they were filled with joy, some spoke in tongue. Later I had a talk with the young people, I learned that many people practice of idol worship here, including young people as well. They really need the power of the Holy Spirit to preach the gospel, but most churches here are very conservative. I prayed for their deliverance and led several to the Lord. After I prayed for the sick, a child was healed of crossed eyes and another blind lady was able to see. People were overjoyed to see God's miracles among them!

In the next morning, we went to the suburb for the coworker meeting of the nearby area. After preaching, I prayed for them. The Holy Spirit moved mightily and they fell down in weeping for a long time. In the afternoon, I prayed for them and they were filled with great joy. Lastly, I prayed for the sick and anointed the towels. Later I returned to the city and prayed for several visitors at the hotel. A minister's daughter was filled with Holy Spirit and spoke in tongues. A young sister received an instant healing that her legs were straightened. I also prayed for the missionary there.

The next day, I took a flight to a major city. After a day of rest, the next morning I went to minister at a house church in the suburbs. The majority was **housewives of the working families** originally from villages. After preaching, I prayed for those who were already in tears. They all fell down and wept strongly. In the afternoon, I prayed for them again and they were filled with joy. Lastly, I prayed for the sick and the deliverance of their husbands. **There are so many believers in the major cities who came from villages**. They need more full-time coworkers to shepherd them.

My Personal Status

It has been a busy year for me with mission trip almost every month. Each trip was less than 3 weeks so I can spend some time with my wife and daughter. My daughter is two and half years old now. Thank God for leading me in the past 18 years of China ministry. As I approach 50 years old, I still have the strength to travel and minister. Thank you for your support and prayers!
