August Mission Trip to Europe

In August, I made a two-week mission trip to **Spain and Italy**. We held meetings at **3 places** and ministered to over **300 people**. The first place is in **Barcelona, Spain**. Not many people showed up at the meeting on Sunday morning. I felt oppression in preaching and only laid hands on several sisters. More people showed up in the afternoon and I felt released in preaching. I first laid hands on the coworkers as they fell down in weeping. Then I laid hands on the children to bless them.

I spent a day of rest in **Bali, Italy** before my flight to **Catalina, Sicily**. Not many people showed up in the afternoon and most were **young people**. After preaching, I laid hands on them and they fell down in weeping. **A young boy was weeping strongly** in the presence of God. I then prayed for healings. After preaching in the evening, I laid hands on the people and they all fell down quietly. A brother fell down in weeping and then spoke in tongues. The next morning, I prayed for people in groups and many were in tears. In the afternoon, I laid hands on them and they fell down in holy laughter. I also prophesied over several people. I then took a flight to **Florence** and preached to the young people group the next morning. When I led the worship in the afternoon, **I felt the presence of God**. After preaching, I first prayed for the young people, and then the mid-age sisters. They all fell down in tears. In the evening, we sang songs in worship and **the presence of God manifested**. After preaching, many came out to receive prayers. I prayed for healings and their personal needs. Many fell down in tears. After preaching in Sunday service the next morning, I prayed for the married couples, young people and children. In the afternoon, they listened to my preaching attentively. The meeting was filled with **the presence of God** and we could not stop singing. Later I prayed for many and they all fell down quietly. In the evening, I led them to praise God in dancing and a breakthrough came. After preaching, I laid hands on those who were hungry for God and they were all filled with great joy. **The Holy Spirit moved mightily**. Lastly, I prayed for those who had personal needs.

I arrived in **Paris, France** at almost midnight and was surprised by more than a dozen people waiting for me at the house of the host family. Because **the leaders of the Revival Church** didn't invite me to minister, I only stopped by Paris for the last two years. I prayed for those people after finishing the meal. I was surprised that **the Holy Spirit moved mightily** and they all fell down in weeping strongly. The older sisters were burdened by the Holy Spirit and interceded for the church until late at night. I then took the flight back to the US next morning. It is my belief according to the Bible that **God today sends out his servants in the same way as Jesus did. Jesus sent out His disciples without waiting for any invitation**. If a place did not receive them, they just brushed the dust off their shoes and went to the next place. The people who did not receive them would lose their blessings and face the judgment. God's work cannot be hindered and the Holy Spirit will testify for His servants.

September Mission Trip to Canada

In early September, I made a mission trip to **Vancouver, Canada** for more than one week. We held meetings in **4 places** and ministered to over **700 people**. On Friday night, I met with young people from **Heavenly Bridge Church** in a fellowship hall at an apartment. After preaching, I laid hands on them and they all fell down quietly. On Saturday night, I first ministered at **New Life Church**, and then at their mother church **Amazing Grace Church** on Sunday afternoon. I preached on the spiritual warfare at the end-time. I then gave an alter call for the couples and many came forward to receive prayers. I then blessed all the children and they fell down quietly. In recent years, there were **many immigrants and students from China** in Vancouver area. These churches are mostly consisted of immigrants from China and also open to the Holy Spirit. That is why I felt a **special burden** to minister here.

I rested during the week and ministered at **Christ Worship Center** on the following weekend. This church is mostly consisted of immigrants from Taiwan. We met at their **new church building**. It is almost completed except for the kitchen. The grace of God is abundant according to their faith, as He prepared such a wonderful meeting hall for the gospel work in this region. On Friday night, I preached at the coworker meeting about being God's Friend. I then prayed for the coworkers and they fell down quietly. On Saturday night, **the presence of God manifested** during worship. I fell on the chair and was filled with the Holy Spirit. I preached about the ministry of worship and then prayed for the worship team. There was **a young student from China** who was greatly filled with the Holy Spirit. Many came to the Sunday morning service and almost packed the main sanctuary. **I felt the holy presence of God** during worship. Senior pastor Chang ministered the communion. I then **preached the Gospel** and it was translated into English. I gave an alter call for repentance and many came up kneeling down in tears. I led several Chinese young people to the Lord. I then laid hands on the people and they fell down quietly in the Holy Spirit.

Ministry Update

I just celebrated my **50th birthday** this year. After my first encounter with God and filled with the Holy Spirit, **I have served the Lord for almost 20 years**. Since 1996 as I started full-time ministry, **thank God for His provision through His people** all over the world, we were able to minister to many churches both in China and overseas. Although we had faced **strong opposition**, especially from **some church leaders**, we looked to God and not men as He faithfully sustained us until this day. The biggest loss in the body of Christ this year was the passing away of **Pastor David Wilkerson**. He was a faithful servant of God and a prophetic voice of this age, preaching God's Word without compromise. He did not seek fame or rich but his impact was far-reaching. There are so many moving testimonies came forth after his death. **His sermons had great impact on my life** for many years. Last year I met him personally for the first time at a conference in Colorado Springs. My desire is to serve God without fear of man just like him.
